#### Dentists offer free oral cancer screenings 6 to underserved Latinos Friday

Local dentists will offer free oral cancer screenings Friday from 8 a.m. to noon at the Mexican Consulate, 410 Baylor St., as part of Binational Health Week, an effort to improve the health of underserved Latinos.

The Jack T. Clark Foundation, an affiliate of the Texas Academy of General Dentistry, is making the screenings possible in partnership with the Ventanilla de Salud Program, which provides health education, screenings and medical referrals to Latinos in partnership with the Mexican Consulate

Since 2001, dentists have screened more than 9,000 people through the Jack T. Clark Foundation, and nearly 6 percent have been referred to a dentist for a follow-up exam, according to the dental academy. Risk factors for oral cancer include tobacco use, alcohol use and prolonged exposure to the sun, the dental academy said.
